The first Art Summit

It's paint, canvas and action this week for Delhiites as India's first Art Summit kicks off in the Capital. With over 35 galleries from India and abroad participating, there are 400 artworks, ranging from paintings to sculpture, photography, installations, drawings, videos and prints, on show.

The international galleries are Art 18/21 from Norwich, UK, Emerging World Art from London, Rob Dean Art, London. While the Emami Auction

House showcases some big artists, young talent finds a platform at the stall hosted by Ashok Art Gallery. The fair opens today in Pragati Maidan at 2 pm in Hall No. 8 and No. 9 and goes on till August 24.
